We have yours of 26th. We now understand that the entire pedestal will be of five ply, except the small extra top section. As to the framing inside, we will have the step heavy enough so one may stand out it without any danger. The only difference is that our idea runs to complete frames at the point where the strain comes in and as stated in a previous letter, we will undertake to make it more than amply strong.

It was our intention that as the glass is shipped set up, to make a complete bottom frame which will lift off with the case part.

As soon as we have your reply that evrything is understood, we will promptly put in work.

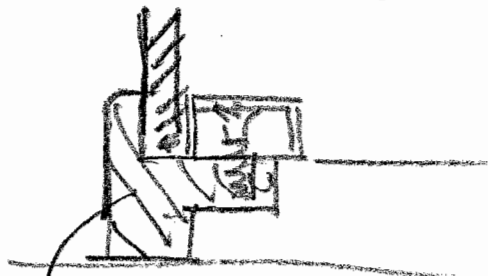
